EIS-ULA Representatives' Training Course

I am writing to let you know that a two-day training course has been organised to provide EIS-ULA representatives, or any member considering becoming a representative*, with an opportunity to widen their knowledge and further develop the skills required to fulfil the role.

The course will be offered over two days and will cover-

- the role and rights of the EIS-ULA rep;
- advising and representing members;
- case study discussion;
- organising an effective union branch and;
- negotiation.

Day 1 will be held on **Wednesday 15 March 2017** and Day 2 on **Wednesday 17 May 2017** in the EIS Training Suite, 46 Moray Place, Edinburgh, EH3 6BH. Both days will run from 9.30 am till 4.00 pm and lunch will be provided.

Members wishing to attend must sign up to <u>both</u> days in order to get the full benefit of the training. Places will be allocated on a first come, first served basis and priority will be given to existing Branch reps.

Time off should be sought in line with local University procedures. Any members wishing to attend who encounter any difficulty in being granted time off i.e. potential reps who are not covered by Trade Union time off agreements, should contact this office ASAP and we will contact your HEI on your behalf.
