

## **Edinburgh Local Association Local AGM Motions 2025**

1. That this AGM notes that Edinburgh already grants facility time to Health and Safety reps as outlined in as provided for by the Health and Safety Executive and outlined in the publications “Safety Representatives and Safety Committees Regulations 1977 (as amended) and Health and Safety (Consultation with Employees) Regulations 1996 (as amended). Approved Codes of Practice and guidance”. However, this AGM also notes the difficulty in implementing this in schools and, therefore, resolves to campaign for ringfenced weekly time following the same model.
2. That this AGM resolves to seek to negotiate an LNCT agreement with Edinburgh Council to allocate 1 hour of protected time per week to any named Student Teacher Mentors for the duration of them undertaking this role.
3. That this AGM resolves that EIS Edinburgh cease using X (formally known as Twitter) for social media communication.
4. That this AGM resolves to find out and report on the number of temporary teaching posts as a percentage of teacher numbers in Edinburgh over the last 5 years, broken down, where possible, to maternity, paternity, long term absence and covering another vacancy.
5. That this AGM resolves to establish a Local Edinburgh Education for Peace Network to continue the work set out in the recently relaunched EIS Education for Peace policy, and with a view to considering the proposal of a motion to establish a National Education for Peace Network in twelve months’ time.
