## **Teachers Pay Award**

On Thursday 25 April, CoSLA (Convention of Scottish Local Authorities), the Scottish Government and Trade Unions agreed a pay award for all colleagues who fall under Scottish National Committee of Teachers. This includes: teachers, educational psychologists, music instructors, education support officers and quality improvement officers.

The agreed pay increases are:

- 2018/19 an increase of 3% this will apply to all teachers and associated professionals
  who are governed by the SNCT bargaining arrangements, up to a cap of £80,000. At, or
  above this figure, a flat rate increase of £1,600 will apply. This award will be backdated to
  1 April 2018
- 2019/20 an increase of 7%
- 2020/21 an increase of 3%

# Change to the Teacher's main grade scale

Changes have been made to the teacher's main grade scale table which take effect April 2019. Further detail of this change is available on the Orb.

## When will you receive your pay increase?

You'll receive your back dated pay increase for 2018/2019, along with the uplift for 2019/2020 in your May salary. This will be paid on Thursday 30 May 2019.
