RECRUITMENT OF NEW MEMBERS

Temporary, Part-Time and Supply Teachers

Please advise student and probationer members that membership of the EIS is free for them. Probationers who were EIS student members have been automatically transferred to full EIS membership. This year's probationers will have free EIS membership until January 2021, and half price membership until September 2021 if they submit direct debit details to the EIS before 31 October 2020.
