If you have not already done so, look for the letter like the one above, open it, read its contents and decide how you want to respond.


Your FELA National Executive is urging you to vote YES and YES—to strike action and to action short of strike action.


WE DESERVE BETTER

Last year you accepted a 2% increase. This amounted to an increase of £831 at the top of the unpromoted lecturer scale. At that time inflation was nowhere near the level that it is raging at now.

However Colleges Scotland are still talking about the same rough figures for a pay increase for lecturers this year.

ARE WE ALL IN THE SAME BOAT?

It is worth noting some increases which Principals have been awarded over the past few years.

The pay rates of Principals in FE has been way out of kilter with the lecturing staff pay rates for many years now. In one College the salary of the Principal rose from £157,000 in session 2018/19 to £164,000 in session 2019/20.

In the same session, there were other rises of £4000 in two colleges, taking one Principal to £127,000 and another to £136,000 respectively.

Why are we quoting this figures?

At the same time that Principals through Colleges Scotland are telling us that they appreciate and recognise how much you have put into the FE service over the past few years, they are also telling us that it is not possible to give you any more than £850 this year and £831 last year, but at the same delivering whopping great rises to Principals to the tune of thousands, in some cases ten thousand plus, pounds.

You have delivered for our students you deserve better than a derisory pay offer that you have already rejected.
