REASONS FOR APPLICATION.

NOTE: The Strike Hardship Fund is intended to be used to support colleagues who are disproportionately impacted by the cycle of strike dates - eg. some part-time lecturers, as a consequence of the pattern of strike days, may lose a significantly higher percentage of their income when compared to a full-time member of staff.
