

## Do you work in an education setting?



Help us understand how many staff in education have had the COVID-19 virus, and how it has affected them, to help Scotland's pandemic response. The main aim of CASS is to try and find out what proportion of Scottish education staff have had the new coronavirus by testing for antibodies in their blood. This type of test looks at whether someone has been infected in the past.

This study will involve completing some survey questions and providing a finger-prick blood sample once a month for antibody testing.

The study will be open to any adult who works in a school or Early Learning & Childcare setting in Scotland.

We would like as many people as possible to complete our survey and then request a test through a UK testing scheme.
