Background to the project

The 2019 pay offer came with an additional package of measures, among which were a number relating to teacher agency:

- Joint work on reducing unnecessary workload
- Establishment of a Teacher Innovation Fund
- Enhancement to the existing Teacher Leadership Programme
- New professional learning opportunities focusing
- on teachers' health and wellbeing.



Enabling Teacher Agency Advisory Group



SNCT approved these measures in April 2019 and the Enabling Teacher Agency (ETA) Advisory Group was convened to take forward a programme of activity focused on workload, wellbeing and agency, with these understood as component elements of empowerment, and the work of the Advisory Group as making a contribution to the empowerment agenda.

The proposals 1-3

- A professional learning programme is in place which supports whole schools and individuals to improve staff health and wellbeing.
- A range of pilots are carried out allowing targeted groups of teachers access to reflective supervision.
- Teachers, or groups of teachers, are able to lead innovative learning activities through access to the Teacher Innovation Fund.

The proposals 4-8

- More teachers access the Teacher Leadership Programme (TLP)
- Enhancements are made to the TLP
- Opportunities are in place for teachers post-TLP to collaborate and further their professional learning
- Capacity is built for enhanced provision of professional learning on coaching and mentoring
- Digital solutions to workload issues are developed following research discovery work into its causes.
